

## Registration eligibility

We have received numerous emails asking about registration eligibility, we appreciate everyone's patience as we are currently reviewing every possible scenario to ensure we are acting responsibly and in accordance to the newly presented framework. Below outlines all of the details pertaining to registration eligibility and player movement for the upcoming season. We also appreciate everyone's understanding and respect of the newly formed movement requirements. These have been put together with heavy consideration of the general safety of our players and families during these times. SCMHA is working diligently to seek OMHA approval to provide programming that will fall into the approved framework of all necessary governing bodies within the hockey, OMHA, OHF, PHU and City of Hamilton and their respective requirements.

**All player movement will be based on 2 integral requirements. Players will either stay with their rostered team from the 2019/2020 season or return to their home centre based on listed residential boundaries.**

**SCMHA is the true home to hockey in Stoney Creek, any player currently residing in Stoney Creek is welcome to register with SCMHA.**

**We encourage and welcome you and your family home.**

### **Player Movement**

As stipulated in the OHF RTP Framework, Players can stay where they were rostered in 2019-20 or return to their home association.

#### **AAA**

Players can stay where they were rostered in 2019-20 or return to their home association. There will be no OHF AAA Waivers available in Stage 3.

#### **Non Resident Players (NRP)**

Players can stay where they were rostered in 2019-20 or return to their home association. There will be no new NRP player movement in 2020-21.

#### **Players who moved Associations via Regulation 3.5**

Players can stay where they were rostered in 2019-20 or return to their home association. This would not be considered as counting toward the two (2) seasons as defined in Policy 4.1.b).

#### **House League**

Players can stay where they were rostered in 2019-20 or return to their home association.

#### **New Players**

MHAs need to have a plan for a player who has moved in or player who did not participate last year and put them in appropriate level

#### **Shared Pilot**

Players in the shared pilot boundaries that were imports in 2019-2020 have the option to stay with the Association they were registered with for 2019-2020 or return to their home association.
