

SCMHA Registration Process

RETURNING PLAYERS REGISTRATION ONLY must register online through the Hockey Canada Registration System (HCR 3.0). Using your member-defined account that was created previously (same username/email and password used last season). The username would be your email used to create the HCR account. Hockey Canada Registry-Login



NEW PLAYERS TO THE SCMHA ASSOCIATION if you have moved into the Stoney Creek area and or have played hockey with another organization in the past seasons. You will have to be either shared on the HCR system with SCMHA if you are playing House League or Local League. Email registration with your child's Name, DOB and where he/she played last. If you have moved to Stoney Creek you will have to do a residential transfer to have your address updated and able to play rep hockey. If you have moved, please go to the **MOVE IN POLICY** TAB under registration to see what is needed to be done.

NEW PLAYERS THAT HAVE NEVER PLAYED HOCKEY, REGISTRATION PROCESS:

You Must complete the Respect in Sport (RIS) Parent version PRIOR to completing the online registration process above. Go to the RIS program to complete

Once parents complete the program (pls select Stoney Creek Minor Hockey Association) an HCR profile will be created, you can then go on the SCMHA online store and register as soon as you have completed the program. Please note, there is a charge of \$12.00 + HST, payable directly to Hockey Canada at the start of the program.
