SUBJECT: Shared Boundary Initiative – NRP Player Movement

In preparation for Year Two of the Shared Boundary Initiative with our Centres in the City of Hamilton, on behalf of the OMHA Board of Directors, I wanted to clarify Non Resident Player (NRP) Player Movement.

The Shared Boundary Agreement stipulates that player movement between the two Associations in the Shared Boundary will not count as NRP movement. In addition, each Centre are permitted two (2) NRP's per season.

No player who resides within the Shared Boundary is eligible for an NRP exemption except to teams 'BB' and below if, the player not offered a Letter of Commitment by the AA or A team within the Shared Boundary.
