EFFECTIVE 2018/2019 SEASON THE FOLLOWING CHANGES WILL TAKE PLACE FOR STONEY CREEK MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION:

- **SCMHA will be reclassified to an “A” center. We will no longer be a recognized “AA” system for the duration of the pilot project**
- Stoney Creek residents wishing to play “AA” will be permitted and encouraged to participate in the Hamilton Huskies “AA” program, where they can try out for “AA”, with no boundary restrictions. Hamilton Huskies residents wishing to play “A” will be permitted and encouraged to participate in the Stoney Creek Minor Hockey Association “A” program, where they can try out for “A”, with no boundary restrictions.
- SCMHA will NO longer be able to supply NRP – Non Resident Passports to our participants and/or residents in the divisions of minor peewee and above, looking to try out for any other “A” center
- SCMHA will no longer be permitted to accept NRP – Non Resident Passports from players from any local “A” center for “AA”. We will still accept NRP – Non Resident Passports from players coming from “AA” centers as well as centers below “A”. As well, SCMHA residents will be permitted NRP – Non Resident Passports to attend tryouts for “AA” Centers.
- This will be a freedom of movement initiative for all hockey players within the boundaries shared by Stoney Creek and Hamilton. This will apply to all players regardless of their current Association that resides within the zones of SCMHA and Hamilton Huskies Hockey Club. Please feel free to reach out to confirm your eligibility with either organization.
- All SCMHA teams will move from the Tri County Minor Hockey League and enter into competition in the Niagara District Hockey League.
- SCMHA will be permitted (2) NRP players from any hockey center that is lower than a classified “A” Centre, and from minor peewee and above.

The level of hockey hierarchy will look as follows and all residents of either zone have freedom of movement from within the shared boundaries.

- **“AA” hockey – Hamilton Huskies** – all shared residents will be eligible for tryouts. Teams will participate in the Alliance Seeded League.
- **“A” hockey – Stoney Creek Warriors** – all shared residents will be eligible for tryouts. Teams will participate in the Niagara District League.
- **“MD” hockey – Hamilton Huskies – NON CONTACT** option for all shared residents for tryouts. Teams will participate in the Alliance Seeded League
- **“AE” hockey – Stoney Creek Warriors** – all shared residents will be eligible for tryouts. Teams will participate in the Niagara District League.
